YES, We Accept...

- **Craft Supplies**
- **Yarn**
- **Fabric** (*as long as it has never been used as bedding, clothing or curtains*)
- **Sewing Supplies and Patterns**
- **Art Supplies**
- **Vintage Items** (*70s or earlier*)
- **Picture Frames**
- **Paper**
- **Corks**
- **Office Supplies**
- **Latex House Paint** (*at least half full, with no rust on the can*)
- **Packing Peanuts**
- **Craft Magazines, National Geographics, Art Magazines**
- **Cool Old Windows and Doors** (*wood only—no vinyl!*)
- **Plywood** (*no particleboard, pressboard, or MDF*)

Items We Can't Take In...

- **NO Food containers**—*except cookie tins*
- **NO Toilet paper or paper towel rolls**
- **NO Styrofoam**
- **NO Appliances**
- **NO Toys**—*we will accept vintage toys, dolls, and army guys*
- **NO Treated lumber, particle board, MDF, drywall, junky wood, or wood with nails/screws in it**
- **NO Prescription/medicine bottles**
- **NO Furniture**
- **NO Window blinds**
- **NO Toiletries** (*e.g., bath salts, perfume, etc.*)
- **NO Batteries**
- **NO Sheets, curtains, comforters, or clothing**
- **NO Oil based paints or stains, spray paint, or paint thinner**
- **NO Household cleaners**
- **NO materials with toxic solvents or other toxic chemicals**
- **NO Computers, printers, monitors, modems, etc.**—*we will accept keyboards*
- **NO Household recycling**
- **Items that can go to a traditional thrift store**
